When constructing a PICOT question, nurses must consider what kind of study design will be appropriate to the problem at hand. This decision will be influenced by a variety of factors such as:

Using this framework, clinicians can develop a well-structured clinical question that will guide them through the EBP process. This is an important step, as the question will dictate how much time a nurse spends looking through scholarly literature. It will also determine the quality of the information gathered.
